

100 Genius Cleaning Hacks

1. Use dryer sheets to wipe baseboards and repel dust.
2. Clean ceiling fan blades with a pillowcase to trap dust.
3. Microwave a bowl of water with lemon slices to loosen food and deodorize.
4. Use white vinegar and water as a natural glass cleaner.
5. Remove water stains on faucets with a cut lemon.
6. Deodorize garbage disposal with frozen vinegar and lemon ice cubes.
7. Use a lint roller to pick up crumbs on furniture.
